MOVE is an eco-revolutionary group who carried out protests in defence of all life. There are currently eight MOVE activists in prison each serving 100 years after been framed for the murder of a cop in 1979. 9th defendant, Merle Africa, died in prison in 1998.

This request is asked in the hope of strenghtening contact between European anti-civ groups by revolving editorial collectives.



Civilisation, our present dominant mode of existence, is characterised by its mass division of labour, mass production and consumption, coercive government, exponential expansion, patriarchy, class stratification, ecological destruction and genocidal war.

This sits in stark contrast to the lives of those external of civilisation's reach, both past and present; lives that are characterised by greater gender equality, egalitarian social relationships and ecological harmony. It is in agriculture that the seeds of the state were sown. Agriculture is a recent historical development; most archaeologists point to its inception 10, 000 years ago, although the reasons for its emergence remain unclear. Prior to this, the vast expanse of human experience (the other 99% of our species history) we lived in **anarchy**, in small scale egalitarian groups. The birth of civilisation saw a fundamental change in our collective mindset; whereas previously we had maintained an equilibrium within the totality of nature, we now came to view it as a resource to be exploited. This domination of the land inevitably led to the commodification and exploitation of both animals and humans; by domesticating other species we learnt in turn to domesticate ourselves. Brutal social relationships such as class stratification and patriarchy are civilisation's enduring legacy.

Agriculture by its very nature requires a sedentary relationship to the land, not the nomadic existence of gatherer/ hunters. Agriculturalists must stay, tend and protect their crops from others, both human and non-human alike, who do not recognise the abstract idea of enclosure. Agriculture therefore gave rise to private property, and by extension discipline and punishment. The linear projection of the field boundary can be seen replicated in the factory walls, prisons and offices of the industrial landscape. Our world is rapidly becoming a wasteland. Cash

crops replace life in all its diversity, agri-chemicals silence the birdsong and poison the land. The small islands of deadened forests are meagre sanctuaries for those animals not deemed to be of value to the system. Meanwhile other animals fill the factories, their lives defined as biological machines. Seas once teeming with life are fished to extinction levels. Wild peoples at civilisation's edges are either assimilated or murdered. Those within its boundaries are increasingly brutalised, through the daily imposition of enforced labour, national identity and a permanent state of terror and war. But all is not yet lost. Inside civilisation's borders a mutiny is growing. Wildfire seeks to report on the actions of those fighting back. This is a pan-european bulletin to facilitate diaglog between like minded groups and individuals taking action; from animal liberation to ecological sabotage, indigenous solidarity to antiwork struggles, these sparks are igniting the fires that will destroy civilisation in all its incumbent horror.

Insurrectionary News

Civilisation prohibits people from surviving through a direct relationship with the land. Today, landlords, corporations and states control the land, charging rent or mortage to the residents. To earn the right to occupy a space in the world, one must accept an income generating position, in an office, factory, mine etc. Unlike hunting/fishing or gathering, such positions typically are not enjoyable or leisurely, but stressful, monotonous, exhausting, and injurious, while in the meantime subjecting one to the exploitative authority of overseers and bosses.

Capitalism; civilisations dominant mode of production cannot be reformed (like the state and civilisation itself.) Across Europe actions against the state and capital, are on the rise. Here are just a few:

Thursday, October 21, 2004

Clashes broke out between riot police and squatters in the Cornella district of Barcelona on Thursday, October 21. Masked squatters set up burning barricades in the streets to fight the eviction and demolition of the "Pati Blau" building, and threw rocks and bottles and shot fireworks at riot police, wounding four officers. At one point during the three-hour battle, squatters stopped a bus, evacuated the passengers, and set fire to the vehicle's tires to use it as a barricade. The squatters eventually fled the area and none were arrested at the scene. The demolition of the building proceeded.

ATHENS, Oct 29 - A roadside bomb exploded on a main Athens road early on Friday as two police riot squad buses passed by.

It was the first bomb attack in Greece since the end of this summer's Athens Olympics, Europe's biggest peacetime security operation.

November 8, 2004

Prison and temp agency bombed in Milan, Italy According to the Italian Ansa news group, the overnight bombings of the San Vittore jail and an Adecco temporary labor agency in Milan have been claimed, through phone-calls, by the "Federazione anarchica informale - cellule insorgenti metropolitane" (Informal Anarchist Federation - Metropolitan Insurgent Cells), who stated that temporary labor agencies "are responsible for the exploitation of millions of people". This group also claimed to have committed a bombing attack on a Manpower agency on October 30, 2004.

Il Silvestre arrests

On 30/07/04 three more people linked to the Italian eco-anarchist group "Il Silvestre" were arrested and 10 houses raided. Two of the three have been accused of preparing & using firebombs. The third has been accused of conspiracy. One has escaped from his house arrest and is now "on the run". see prisoner support.

Reports from Protest Camps

Hungary - Nato radar construction halted.

Hungary's defence ministry has ordered a halt to the construction of a Nato radar station on a nature reserve after protests by environmentalists. Officials said it was important to balance environmental and security concerns, and an independent inquiry would be set up to assess the project. The Nato facility near Pecs in southern Hungary has been the target of regular protests by green activists. 200 demonstrators from the local area managed to halt construction work at the site by standing in ditches and surrounded machinery in an effort to stop digging or the laying of cables.

Russia - A protest camp in Perm has been running from the 20th of August, and is still going strong. The protest camp is a total revoke of the criminal program to utilise rocket engines and their fuel in Perm. Protesters believe 'the governments disarmament program isn't taking into account the health and welfare of local people, which currently seem to have no value whatsoever to military-industrial complex. Protesters also object to the building of a missile dismantling plant located right int the suburbs of a city with more than one million inhabitants'.



Actions against the new technologies of control.

From recent communique in Leeds, UK:

'Nanotechnology is the newest weapon against diversity, rebellion, difference, autonomy and freedom. The US military is, of course, the biggest investor as it tries to ensure total domination of all life on the planet. The British government has also invested £90 million in nanotechnology and most industries and universities* are developing interests in the field.Genetic engineering was recognised as having massive social and ecological implications and this ensured worldwide resistance against it. Nanotechnology, which has the ability to transform all matter, has far more dramatic effects and needs drastic action to confront this new assault on diversity of life. Nanotech, and its links to biotechnological, informational and cognitive sciences, provides the state with yet more tools with which to control all dissent and iron out all life into a homogeneous, manipulable mass. Be it advances in surveillance technologies, the ability to disable neural transmitters and break apart DNA strands by remote

control, artificially create workaholism in labourers, or stamp out physical and mental difference, nanotechnology puts mind control, body control, social control and control of the natural world more firmly in the hands of the state, the corporations and the ruling elite. Just as biotechnology was sold to us as a green technology that would feed the world, so nanotech is being heralded. Both instinct and reason tell us to take action against these new technologies before we lose our last liberties to them.

Nanotech action in Leeds, UK

On Friday 12th Nov, there was an action against Nanotechnology/Convergence Technologies at the Royal Armouries in Leeds. The hall was visited and made extremely unplesant by a well-known substance for stinking out conferences, the tannoy was seized and a communique read out. This coincided with a talk on nanotech which drowned it out. Leaflets were also scattered down.

GM

Finland's growing biotech industry has tried to add GM trees to its already existing vast forest cover; however activists soon cut the experiment short by felling all the genetically engineered trees

In **Germany**, activists destroyed a field of GM potatoes produced by the large German corporation Bayer. Bayer is one of the key player in the European biotech industry.

In the **Netherlands**, the farmers co-operative, which for many years has attracted the attention of activists for its research on GM potatoes, once again lost one of its field trials to a decontamination action. It still has seven field trials in Netherlands.

Spain is the only place in Europe where genetically modified food is grown commercially. Even so, public interest in the issue has increased and a platform of groups, called Transgenics Fora!, took it upon themselves to cut down a field of genetically engineered wheat.

In the **UK** a series of nation wide actions targeted one of its largest supermarket chains, Sainsbury's, which is producing its own brand milk from cows fed with GM feed. Actions were wide and varied, from pickets at the Sainsbury's shareholders meeting, to blockades of storage depots in Birmingham

Animal Liberation

The stuggle for animal liberation is an important battleground in the fight against civilisation. Their domestication



is mirrored in our own. Yearly, millions of animals are murdered and tortured for the needs of profit. Bite Back.

Across Europe there was a week of actions in rememberance of Barry Horne, a UK animal liberationist who died on hunger strike.

Italy

October 13th Parma: Two lorries of a meat company called "Pronto carni" have been attacked with fire, one of them was burnt. The media didn't mention this action. The communique stated the action was made in solidarity with Sergio, Alessio and William, and also with all the other activists of Il Silvestre at house arrests or on the run!" October 30th, Firenze: a communique says activists went to damage for the third time a fur shop and finally found it closed!

November 2nd, Milano: 2 fur shops had locks glued remembering Barry Horne. November 5th, San Daniele: a sportive fishing pond has been damaged in remembrance of Barry Horne. November 6th, val di Ledro: 30 birds have been freed from a new group calling itself ALT /Animal Liberation Trentino (Trentino is an Italian region). The birds were kept by hunters to call other birds and shoot them.

Sweden

Actions against furshops were the focus of Swedish ALF as it remembered Barry Horne, with 5 actions in just 5 days against 6 leather and fur shops in south Sweden.

Russia

September 26th, Moscow: The metal jalousie and walls of two fur & leather stores were spray-painted with slogans. October 4th: The fur store in Koryazhma

(Arkhangelsk region) was spray-painted by red paint. On the meat plant walls were left vegan slogans.

November 11th: Activists visited Hunting Society with its shop at Koryazhma city in Arkhangelsk region (North West Russia). The keyhole of the lock was filled up with construction foam. They also left slogans against hunting using paint.

Indigenous Solidarity

Throughout the Pacific Rim wild nature and wild culture are under attack. At the beginning of the 21st century we all have to choose sides. Do we remain on the side of industrial civilisation, or do we stand with wild cultures and radical social movements - in defence of the living earth?



Solidarity South Pacific exists to aid West Papuan tribal resistance, Earth First! and indigenous people in the Philippines, and to bring attention to the revolution on Bougainville. They carry out solidarity actions inside leviathon, raise money to send as direct aid and produce publications bringing the voices of rebels in the South Pacific unmediated. **See Contacts**

Text taken from SSP newsletter:

'loggers tear down the forests. Mining corporations rip open chasms in the earth. Free tribal societies are either exterminated or assimilated. In this century, over half of the earth's diverse forms of life are facing extinction - these are critical times.

The Pacific Rim, with its rainforest expanses, surviving pockets of wild peoples and coral reefs is a critical field of battle. Against the death culture rebellion grows. The victorious ecoinsurrection in Bougainville and the strengthening resistance in Papua are just two examples.'

On Monday 5th July twenty people held a demonstration at the Indonesian embassy in London in solidarity with West Papua. who were refusing to vote in the Indonesian presidential elections.

As all the expat Indonesians turned up to vote they were confronted with banners reading 'Free West Papua' and 'Solidarity with the OPM'. Many stopped to talk and they were handed leaflets which read:

"SOLIDARITY WITH THE WEST PAPUAN ELECTION BOYCOTT!! Today West Papuans are boycotting the Indonesian election. Their lands are ravaged, their peoples destroyed. Why should they participate in choosing their executioner?

Previous refusals to vote have led to massacres. We are here to support their tribal struggle against genocide and ecocide. If voting changed anything they'd make it illegal, instead in Indonesia it's compulsory.

Resistance to the Election: Today for the second time in three months West Papuans are showing their contempt for their oppressors by boycotting elections. In April's parliamentary elections the majority of West Papuan's refused to vote, polling stations were burnt and a boat carrying ballot papers was sunk. At the same time solidarity demonstrations took place across Europe, America and Australia. Today there is the same refusal of the presidential elections in West Papua. Faced with death, imprisonment and the destruction of their forests it is no surprise that Papuans resist being forced to vote for the likes of murderous Wiranto and Megawatti.

Do not be fooled, elections are but theatre. Behind the scenes it is money and guns that makes politics. What small gains in freedom the Indonesian peoples have today are not gifts of 'Democracy', but of the fear the wealthy feel when they remember the insurrection that brought down Suharto. Today fire burns in the hearts of the tribal warriors of West Papua as it did in those of the Jakarta rioters of 1998.
